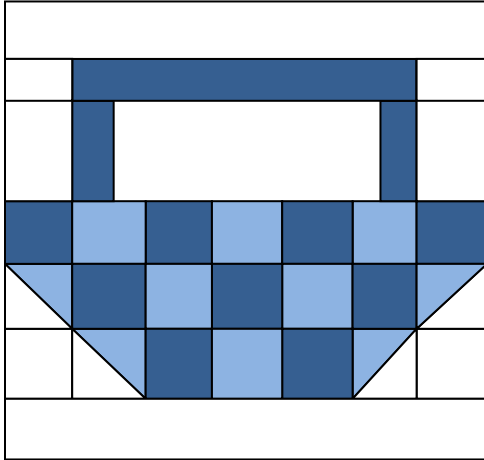


# WHAT'S IN YOUR BASKET

7 inch block finished  
7 ½ inch block unfinished  
Due August 2011



## Dark Fabric:

9 – 1 ½ x 1 ½ inch squares  
2 – 1 ¼ x 2 ½ inch rectangles  
1 – 1 ¼ x 5 ½ inch rectangle

## Medium Fabric:

2 – 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 inch squares  
6 – 1 ½ x 1 ½ inch squares

## Light Fabric:

2 – 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 inch squares  
2 – 1 ½ x 1 ½ inch squares  
2 – 1 ½ x 2 ½ inch rectangles  
2 – 1 ¼ x 1 ½ inch rectangles  
2 – 1 ¼ x 7 ½ inch rectangles  
1 – 2 ½ x 4 inch rectangle

1. Place the medium 2 7/8 inch squares with right sides together, draw a line down the middle of each light square. Sew on each side of the drawn line, cut along drawn line to make 2 half triangles.
2. Sew the basket squares together and half triangles together to make the body of the basket.
3. Sew the rectangles together to make the handle area.
4. Sew the long rectangles to top and bottom of basket.
5. Now, is the fun part, fill your basket with something, ie.....balls of yarn, fruit, flowers, chocolate. (If you don't want to embroider/appliqué stuff into your basket, pick a fabric that will represent what you want to fill your basket with and use this fabric in place of the 2 ½ x 4 inch rectangle.
