### WHAT TYPE OF QUILT SHOULD I MAKE?

Size: Twin sized (39" x 76") or larger

Style/Pattern/Colors: Your choice! Gender neutral is nice, but feel free to use any styles and colors that you like.

Things to avoid: Names, dates, religious messages, holiday themes (particularly Halloween/death themes)

### HOW MANY QUILTS ARE NEEDED and WHEN DO YOU NEED THEM?

We are hosting 80 campers this summer and need a quilt for each of them. We need the quilts by the end of June.

### HOW DO I GET THE COMPLETED QUILTS TO YOU?

Drop them off at the address listed below, or if you are near another Providence facility, email Christi and she will help coordinate a drop-off somewhere near you
