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## **AUTUMN SUNSET SUPPLIES**

There are 25 to 30 different fabrics in this quilt that range from dark purple to mixed purple and orange/yellow to orange and finally yellow. This makes the flow from one color to another. You don't need much of any one fabric so raid your scraps.

- 25-30 fabrics ranging from purple to yellow (batiks work well)
- scraps of medium to light green for pumpkin plant
- scraps of yellow and orange for flower and pumpkin
- Omnigrid # 96 ruler OR Creative Grid Quick Trim and Circle if you have one
- Cutter and mat
- Sewing machine with new needle
- Your usual tools, (seam ripper, small scissors, pins, chocolate)
- Fabric for design wall
- Pellon fusible 805 (You probably won't get that far, but it's my current favorite fusible.)
- Pattern will be provided

To get right into the design phase, please precut at least some of your strips. If you have one of the rulers listed above, cut your strips to  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches. If you want to cut squares and cut them in half, cut strips  $3\frac{7}{8}$  inches.
