Lullaby Quilts



On average, 150 small baby quilts are needed for Emanuel and St. Vincent hospitals Neonatal Intensive Care units every month. These quilts are given to every newborn entering the NICU for the first time. It is a small gesture of love to parents who are struggling with the uncertainty of the health of their child.

Bring your machine, some basic supplies and join others in making quilts for these babies. Quilt kits are available or you can bring your own to work on. Sharon's Attic has four machines available to borrow on a first come first serve basis (2 Bernina & 2 Pfaff)

Quilts need to be smaller than 36" square (rectangles are acceptable). Fabric needs to be 100% cotton (cotton/flannel is acceptable). Batting needs to be 100% cotton (Warm & Natural is acceptable). Thread can be cotton or polyester. Machine quilting spacing needs to be no wider than 4 ½" (no "tied" quilts please).

Quilts can have any pattern or design (no embellishments please...buttons, ribbons, etc)

If you would like to donate a quilt or wish to donate batting or thread but can't come to the monthly gathering, please deliver to Sharon's Attic with a note attached for Lullaby Quilts; ATTN: Lauria Mandich
