Our mission first is to provide love a sense of security, warmth and comfort to children from 0-18 who are seriously ill traumatized, or otherwise in need through the gifts of new handmade blankets, created by volunteer blanketeers

Second, we want to provide a rewarding and fun service opportunity for individuals and groups in the communities for the benefit of children

Locally in the past 21 years our chapter has made and donated over 87,000 blankets. We provide quilts, blankets and afghans to places like Randall Childrens Hospital, Doernbecher Hospital, Babies In Need and many social service agencies. Last month we delivered over 750 blankets

Our quilt and blanket guidelines (these are approximate):

Baby – minimum 36” x 40”

Child – 40” – 60”

Teen – 45” – 72”

We accept quilt tops, completed quilts, quilting fabric and batting. Items must be new and free of odors and pet hair. We are always looking for people who do longarming.

We are blessed to have a location in Vancouver where we meet three Thursdays a month to accept donations, inspect and pack blankets. We offer fabric to those who will use it to make a quilt for us.

We have a Sit & Sew day once a month at a different location where we learn a new quilt block and make a group quilt, or just sew our own Linus projects.

Blankets can be brought to our location or there are Project Linus donation bins in all of the area Joann's Fabric stores.
